The partners **share common goals and work together** towards mutually beneficial results and outcomes. The results and expected outcomes are clearly defined, realistic and address the issues identified in the needs analysis.

- Stimulate entrepreneurship skills in higher education
- Facilitate the exchange, flow and co-creation of knowledge

Eligible Organizations for applying

- a higher education institution or research institute;
- a public or private, small, medium or large enterprise (including social enterprises);
- a public body at local, regional or national level;
- an organisation active in the field of education, training and youth;
- an intermediary or association which represents enterprises;
- an accreditation, certification or qualification body

- jointly developing and implementing **new learning and teaching methods** (like new **multidisciplinary curricula**, **learner-centred** and **real problem-based teaching and learning**)
- organising **continuing educational programmes and activities with and within companies**

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Knowledge Alliances focus

Creating **schemes of transversal skills** learning and applications

Embedding **entrepreneurship education** to provide knowledge and skills

Opening up **new learning opportunities** through the practical application of entrepreneurial skills



Knowledge Alliances can focus on:

- creating **schemes of transversal skills** learning and application throughout higher education programmes developed in cooperation with enterprises aiming at strengthening employability, creativity
- **embedding entrepreneurship education** in any discipline to provide students, researchers, staff and educators with the knowledge, skills
- **opening up new learning opportunities** through the practical application of entrepreneurial skills, which can involve and/or lead to the **commercialisation of new services, products and prototypes.**
