






CONTEXT The Area of Reggio Emilia





Nationally: mismatch between the employment needs of companies and the currently present workforce.

In the Reggio Emilia area: low unemployment rate with consequent difficulty in finding human resources.



WHAT PROJECT

Virtuslab*RE: comes from the joint initiative between the Augurusa Foundation and Unindustria Reggio Emilia with the aim to enhance the human capital needed by local companies. The project aims to train and employ 3000 suitable profiles over 3 years by providing free skill-certified training courses.



HOW PILLARS

Through a participatory planning model, to identify strategic and operational actions, such as:

- recruitment and selection
- professional training
- co-living platform, social inclusion and job placement

The project sustainability involves stakeholder support with in-kind contributions and Forma.temp financial support



WHO PROMOTERS

The **Foundation** deals with education and social inclusion through charitable initiatives, along with creating high social impact models on a global scale.

Unindustria is a reference point for businesses and an element of propulsion for the development of the Reggio Emilia territorial system.
